

Gujarati Samaj Youth Camp 2010 – એકત્વ (Unity)

What is Gujarati Samaj (GS)? – The only leading non-profit organization in Gujarati community, GUJARATI SAMAJ has been providing a platform for our community to come together and share cultural values for past 32 years.

What is Samaj Camp? – GS Youth Camp has been a great way for our children to come together in a safe, nurturing environment to learn about our rich cultural heritage, learn and share common values, and learn to work together that defines એકત્વ.

This year Youth Camp will have an opportunity to learn about Major Cities of Gujarat, theme of એકત્વ (unity), frequently used Gujarati words, Indian games, etc..

Who can attend? – All Gujarati Samaj members and non-members children between the age of 5 and 14 can attend the camp. Active GS member children will have the priority over the non-members children, however all Gujaratis are encouraged to attend the camp.

When is it? – This year the camp will be conducted for 10 consecutive weekdays from June 14th to June 25th with one day of field trip (optional).

How many campers? – Gujarati Samaj will try to accommodate everyone however due to overwhelming response applications will be processed on first come first serve basis.

Where is it? – Youth camp has always been held at the **Gujarati Samaj Hall** in Tucker, GA. Actual camp hours are from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 PM p.m. each day. Parents will be able to drop off their children at 8:45 AM and pickup their children by 4:15 PM, there will be a supervisor(s) on site between these times.

When is the deadline? Completed registration forms need to be postmarked by **17th April, 2010**. Registration forms will be NOT be accepted after the deadline

How much does it cost? – The Camp fee for the two weeks camp is \$150 per child. Checks MUST be attached with the form.

What about food? – While attending Youth Camp, children will be provided two snacks and a lunch. Food from home is NOT allowed unless your child has allergies (prior approval is required)
